## Désirée Cowl

### Sizes and measurements:

One size fits most, 5.5" wide and 66" circumference.

### Materials:

**frabjous fibers "Hand Picked: Pastel I": 2 skeins**

100% recycled silk; approx. 100 yd per 100g skein

**frabjous fibers "Sari Ribbon -lightweight, salmon": 2 skeins**

**Hooks:** N (10.00 mm)

**Notions:** Yarn needle to weave in ends.

**Gauge:** Not important

**Abbreviations:** ch - chain, dc - double crochet, fdc - foundation double crochet, lp - loop, lps - loops, sl st - slip stitch, st (s) - stitch (es), beg - beginning, rnd - round

**Pattern Note:** The cowl is worked in the round with the edging worked afterwards.

### Stitch Guide:

#### Foundation double crochet (Fdc)

Ch-3, yo, insert hook under two strands of third chain from hook, yo, pull up a lp, yo, pull lp through 1 lp (3 lps on hook). Complete stitch as a normal double crochet (yo, pull through two lps) twice. First stitch made. \*Yo, insert hook under two strands of first chain made. Yo, pull lp through ch, yo, pull lp through 1 lp (3 lps on hook). Complete stitch as a normal double crochet (yo, pull through two lps) twice. Second stitch made. Repeat from \* for each stitch for desired length.

#### Love Knot Edging:

\*Pull up loop on hook 1" long. Yarn over and pull through the loop, yarn over and pull through another loop. Skip 2 dc and sc in next st. Repeat from \* around ending with a sc.

#### Pattern instructions:

Loosely work 100 Fdc. For longer/shorter cowl, work more/less Fdc (in multiples of 2). Join for working in the round with sl st. Place maker to indicate beg of rnd.

**Rnd 1:** Ch-2, \*dc in next st, sc in next st; repeat from \* around.

**Rnd 2:** Ch-1, \*sc in next st, dc in next st; repeat from \* around.

Repeat rnds 1 & 2 until piece measures approx. 3" wide. Fasten off and break yarn.

Note: If your goal is to use up all your yarn, work until you have approx. 6" of yarn left.

Work love knot edging as follows for both edges:

Join ribbon yarn with slip stitch. Work 1 dc in each st around once.

Work Love Knot Edging (see Stitch Guide). Fasten off and weave in ends.
